Purpose: The Immunization Skills Institute (ISI) is an innovative course designed to train medical staff who provide immunizations on current, effective and caring immunization techniques. This four-hour training combines lecture, video, and hands on practice sessions to increase immunization competency.

Learning Objectives: After completing the ISI class, participants will be able to demonstrate an understanding of the following components:

- Immunization best and evidence based practices
- Vaccine Storage & Handling
- Vaccine Preparation and Administration
- Immunization Documentation and After Care
